

WHAT TO BRING ON FRIDAY NIGHT TO REGISTER YOUR TEAM

- Any outstanding TRAVEL PERMIT and PAYMENT
- Team Roster
- Player ID card or Book
- OSA Roster for U-13 and up teams (Tournament Teams)
- Team OSA number for Festival Teams

WHAT YOU WILL RECEIVE FRIDAY NIGHT DURING TEAM REGISTRATION

- Wrist Band for each player on a TOURNAMENT team (U-13 to U-18)
- Commemorative Medallion for each player on a FESTIVAL team (U-09 to U-12)
- Copy of Approved Team Roster
- Any last minute schedule changes

WHAT TO DO FOR YOUR FIRST GAME ON EITHER SATURDAY OR SUNDAY

- Arrive at least 30 minutes before your 1st game of the day
- Bring copy of Approved Team Roster (from Registration Night), along with the Player Id cards or Books for each player, and the wristbands for the TOURNAMENT team players, and the players to the Field Convenor to validate the identify of each player
- For the TOURNAMENT teams, once the player ID is validated, have the Manager place the wristband on each player; wristbands stay on until your team is eliminated from play
- Field Convenor has extra wristbands if a wristband is broken; Field Convenor also has scissors to trim off any excess from wristbands.

WHAT TO DO PRIOR TO EACH SUBSEQUENT GAME

- Go to Field Convenor at least 15 minutes before your game
- Filed Convenor has the official Game Sheet
- You will either need to fill in the Game Sheet or glue your prefilled Excel Game Sheet in the appropriate area (Home team or Visiting team, as per schedule, Home team is listed on the left side); Field Convenor has glue sticks and pens to complete the Official Game Sheet.
- Make sure to strike out any player who is not playing or has been suspended during the TOURNAMENT or FESTIVAL.
- Official Game Sheet along with the Referee Payment Cards remain in the possession of the Field Convenor; Referee will come to Field Convenor to obtain payment cards and fill in the results of the game (where appropriate).
